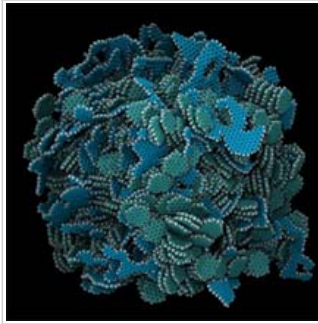


Physics Students Access the Power of Titan

Students enrolled in **Physics 643 (Computational Physics)** (<https://sites.google.com/site/utkp643/>) are required to complete a semester-long research project, which is not an unusual course requirement. The difference for these students in **Professor Ken Read's** (<http://www.phys.utk.edu/faculty/faculty-read.html>) class is that they have access to the Titan supercomputer at Oak Ridge National Laboratory.
